Less than two years before the activation of the Kampala Amendments on the crime of aggression, 24 States from all regions of the world have already ratified, with many more ratifications expected in the coming months. Not much time remains for States to ratify, if they wish to be among the first 30 ratifications required for the exercise of the Court's jurisdiction. **At this side event, panelists will consider ways of ensuring the highest possible number of ratifications of the crime of aggression amendments as well as the modalities of the activation decision in 2017. Participants are encouraged to participate in the interactive discussion and to share updates on the ratification procedures in their own countries.**
